Minutes of Previous Meeting & Matters Arising

The minutes of the previous meeting were not available, but the main points of interest were reviewed & agreed.

Treasurer's Report

Steff reported that at present there is approximately £18 to £1900 in the club account, with nothing currently outstanding to be paid.

After discussion amongst the committee it was proposed by Steff and seconded by Andy that we should lower the amount of subs collected from players to £25.00 for senior players & £10.00 for students and those unemployed.

A vote was taken and duly passed.

Steff also brought up the subject of the funds currently sat in the club's account that forms the funds given by Don Greggains wife, Ann.

The funds were to help us with developing youth cricket within the club, but our present lack of under 18's prompted Steff to ask Herb if we could possibly reallocate the funds. Herb agreed to speak to Ann to ascertain whether this may be an option.

Colin reported that there a few items that we need before the new season kicks off, such as a new scorebook & hole marker for the wicket. This he will obtain & be reimbursed.

Finally it has been agreed to meet at the pavilion in April to have a clean up & see if there is a way to get the sight screens functional.
